How are the courses studied?

Attend seven Saturday workshops (9am-5pm) over a ten week period and study the rest from home.

Where are the workshops held?

Gold Coast - Bond University, Brisbane - Fortitude Valley PCYC or external (no workshops).

Do I have to attend every workshop?

No, you may attend all, some or none depending on your personal commitments. You can access all resources online and receive hardcopy resources in the mail.

Do I need a computer?

Yes, computer skills are essential for you to pass the police academy, so we have built this into the course.

What software do I need?

Microsoft office (word, PowerPoint) 2003 or 2007, Windows 2000, XP or Vista.

Do I need the internet?

Yes, this is really important. Broadband is essential, with a minimum download speed of 512kbps, but we suggest you have the fastest connection you can receive in your area to ensure you can play our comprehensive library of online videos smoothly. Also, minimum monthly download should be 5gb.

What if I cannot meet the internet requirements?

Internet access is essential as you are required to submit all assessments online. However, if your speed is an issue and you cannot upgrade, DVD's are available with all course resources (computer will need DVD player).

What do the courses include?

Everything the QPS request and more to ensure you have the best possible chance of success - theory depending on work experience, fitness (beep test preparation), swim proficiency, senior first aid, typing practice, psychometric and interview preparation, defensive driving for provisional drivers, seven day a week support.

Who will be teaching me?

Queensland Police Sergeants and Senior Sergeants, Solicitors, former Australian Federal Police, Queensland Probation and Parole officers and Criminologist.

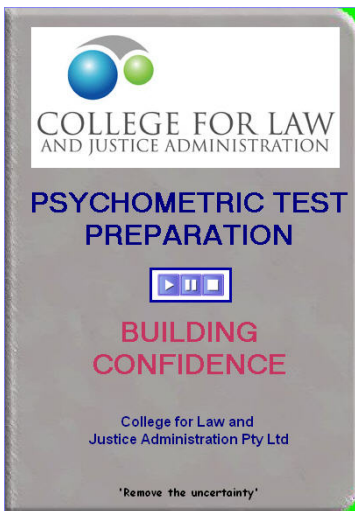
